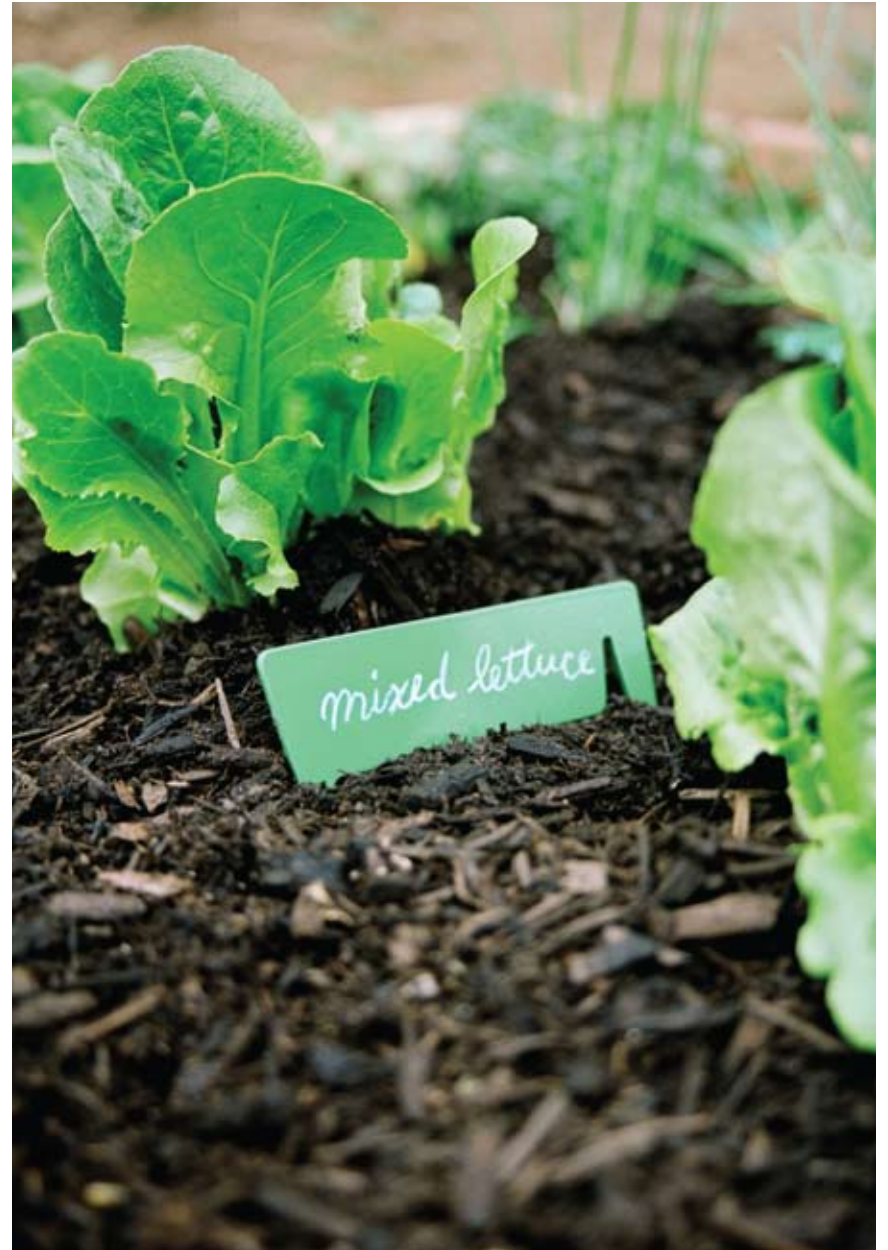
Introducing: The S.R. Raised Garden Box

Just in time for Spring, Los Angeles based design studio Scout Regalia introduces a new way to build home gardens and promote sustainable food production.

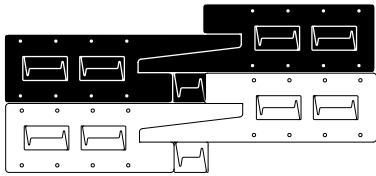
The S.R. Raised Garden Box is designed to simplify the process of assembling a raised bed garden, making food production feasible for green thumbs and the garden challenged alike. The Kit allows for gardens of variable sizes and lengths, making it ideal for urban settings with soil and space constraints.





Minimize Waste, Maximize (Food) Production:

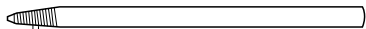
The S.R. Raised Garden Box Kits have been designed and fabricated with sustainability principles in mind:



Kit pieces have been designed to minimize waste and maximize material. Garden tags are punched out of the remnants of larger pieces.



Requiring the home gardener to obtain their own lumber promotes sustainable practices. It encourages people to use regionally harvested lumber, salvaged wood, composite decking, or other reclaimed material sources.

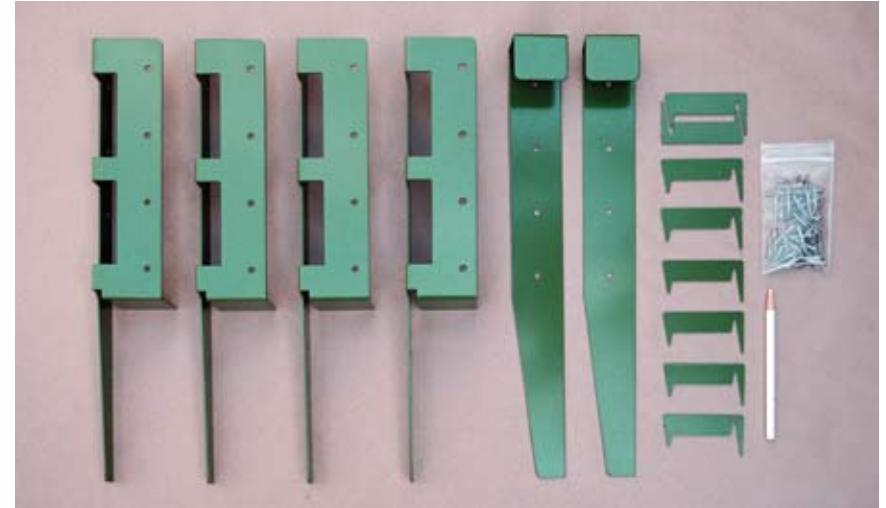


Garden ID tags are reusable for many seasons to come. The grease pencil provides a non-water soluble marker to label plants in the garden. Re-tag new plants by wiping the ID tags with rubbing alcohol or a damp cloth.



We work with local fabricators to produce the Kits. S.R. Raised Garden Box Kits are proudly designed and manufactured in California.
